As a former consul myself, and as secretary of the local consular corps, I discovered early in my work how civic, business, and educational leaders were eagerly looking for information on how to deal with the consuls among them. Each may have had a different motive but all of them were united in their effort to understand such matters as titles (why is someone a consul general and not a consul?), functions (can a vice consul help me with a business lead in his country?), the meaning of the two universal classifications (can an honorary consul be as useful as a career consul?), etc.
